

Call for Proposals
Advancing Learning with Technology Symposium
Friday February 28, 2014

The IUPUI Center for Teaching and Learning (CTL) is accepting proposals for the 2014 Advancing Learning with Technology (ALT) Symposium. **Proposals are due on November 8, 2014.** The event will take place on **Friday, February 28, 2014** from 9:00 am to 12:30 pm. We hope you will consider submitting a proposal, and we encourage you to share this invitation and information with your colleagues.

The ALT Symposium brings the higher education community together to examine and showcase instructional technology strategies that impact learning across a variety of disciplines. The program will include 50-minute breakout sessions possible formats include panel and roundtable discussions, lecture-discussion, interactive workshops, and poster presentations. Proposals that include graduate students or involve student presenters are welcome. We especially encourage exploring these and similar questions, but proposals need not be limited to these topics:

- How are you using instructional technology to facilitate student engagement and collaboration?
- How are you assessing the impact of technology on student learning?
- What are the best practices to incorporate mobile learning platforms in the classroom?
- How are you using virtual worlds to conduct authentic learner-based experiences?
- What strategies are you using to increase student learning and success in an online format?
- How are you incorporating gaming and simulations in the curriculum?
- Other

All proposals will be reviewed by a committee that includes faculty and CTL staff. Proposals will be reviewed based upon the following criteria:

- Innovative use of technology in class or online
- Use of technology to enhance a specific pedagogy
- Promotion of student engagement using technology
- Reflection on, assessment of the use of technology
- Demonstration of educational significance, building on what is known in the literature
- Thoroughness, quality, and clarity of proposal

Online proposal submissions will begin 10/1/2013 and will be accepted until 11/8/2013.
